## 6<sup>th</sup> to 10<sup>th</sup> Entrance Test

### Instructions for Parents

1. Students should report at the test center 30 minutes before according to the session allotted.
2. Student should bring admit card with photo affixed, **2 black ball pens**.
3. To reach his / her classroom, the student needs to know his / her **group number** and **seat number** correctly. For this reason, the student **MUST** have the admit card with him / her.
4. Once the candidate enters the school premises, the teachers and the volunteers take care of the student. The parents are not allowed to wait inside the school premises after leaving the student.
5. Parents are not allowed to enter the classroom. Once the students enter the school premises, volunteers guide the students to their respective classrooms.
6. After the test, the students are brought to the ground floor. Parents are requested to wait in the square on the ground floor to take their children.
7. **In No case** the request for change in assigned batch will be entertained.
8. Answers will be assessed by using O.M.R. technique. Students should practise it well . Please see the sample of the answersheet in the picture given below.

**Instructions for appearing for the test in COVID scenario**
